

Welcome to Marinduque . . .

Location

Marinduque is the heart of the Philippine archipelago, the island province lies 170 kilometers southeast of Manila. It is bounded on the north and east by Quezon, west by Oriental Mindoro and South by Romblon.

History

Legendary stories narrate that the original name of the island was “Malindik” describing the gentle sloping terrain of the island’s highest mountain Mt. Malindig. When the Spaniards came, they found it hard to pronounce the word so they called the island Marinduc. By common usage, Marinduc became Marinduque.

Land Area

It is the regions smallest province with a total land area of 95,920 square kilometers.

Climate

Marinduque can be categorized as Type IV, rainfall more or less is evenly distributed throughout the year with no close boundary between dry and wet season.

Population

The province has a population of approximately 217,000 based on the 2000 NCSO survey.

Municipalities

Boac, the capital town, Buenavista, Gasan, Mogpog, Sta. Cruz and Torrijos with 218 barangays province-wide.

Getting to Marinduque

By Land & Sea:

JAC, JAM, Tritran, Lucena Lines and South Star Bus companies service the Manila – Lucena route. Choose specific buses that bring passengers to Talao-Talao Pier, Brgy. Talao-talao, Lucena City. (Tip: look for “ Talao-Talao/Dalahican Pier “ signboard on their front windshield or inquire from their conductor.

There are door-to-door van transport service mostly Besta, L-300, Hiace and Benz vans that pick you up directly from your Metro Manila residence and bring you all the way to Talao-Talao Pier in Dalahican, Lucena City or directly to Marinduque. Phone Nos. 646-4717, 713-5310, 741-1233 and 801-6347; all with telephone area code (02) for Metro Manila.

From Talao-Talao Pier, you can choose Balanacan Port in Mogpog for passengers bound for Mogpog, Boac, Gasan and Buenavista. For Sta.Cruz and Torrijos bound passengers they may choose Buyabod Pier. It is also possible to bring your cars, vans, trucks and buses to Marinduque through the roll-on, roll-off ferries servicing the same sea route. (Tip: vehiches are loaded on first come-first serve basis, also bring xerox copy of OR & CR of vehicle).

From Balanacan Port. air-con FX, vans and regular passenger jeepneys and tricycles take you to your local hotel or residence. From Buyabod Pier, tricycles and jeepneys take you to Sta.Cruz poblacion where air-con vans and regular jeepney are available for Torrijos-bound passengers.
